Proposed Program for Expanded Research in Food and Nutrition Apr 11 2021

Abstract: In 1963, the USDA's research program in food and nutrition was funded at less than \$2 million; the increases proposed for the following 3 year period included an increase of professional staff from 80 to 148, expansion of existing facilities at Beltsville, and construction of 3 new laboratories in other parts of the country raising the cost of \$9 million. Programs to be implemented were investigations of fat in the diet, nutritional adequacy, nutrient utilization, consumer research, aging, food composition, nutrient content, and processing effects.
