Two new ionization techniques introduced in the late 1980s, electrospray ionization (ESI) and matrix-assisted laser desorption/ionization (MALDI), resulted in a breakthrough in mass spectrometry, enabling its use in molecular weight and primary structure determination of biopolymers larger than 100 kDa. Recently it has been discovered that ESI mass spectrometry may also be used to characterize complexes containing noncovalent interactions, thus opening new perspectives for supramolecular chemistry. ESI mass spectrometry has the advantage that the sample is introduced from a homogeneous solution which can be maintained at near physiological conditions of pH, concentration, and temperature.
